Arroz	Arrows	Rice	I'm in a Chinese restaurant. Burglars burst in through the front door so I throw my bowl of rice at them. The rice turns into arrows which pin the burglars to the wall.
Pluma	Puma	Pen	I'm in a Puma shop and I've just found this amazing pair of shoes. As I put the pair on, the puma on the logo comes to life, and starts chasing me around the shop. I grab a pen and hypnotise the puma.
Camarero	Camera & Aero	Waiter	I'm at my favourite café and I ask the waiter if he can take a photo of me. But just as he clicks the button to take the photo on his camera, a whole bunch of aero bars fly out and hit me in the face and are thudding against me.
